

## System Log Filters

### Log On/Off

This tracks the Dates and times Users Log into and out of Manitou. This can be used to verify the times between clocking into time tracking and Manitou during shift changes.

### Report Server

Lists any successes, or failures, of ad hoc, or scheduled reports.

### Publisher

Lists any successes, abortion, or failures, of any ad hoc, or scheduled report publishing, including any failure reason.

### Watchdog Messages

When Watchdog messages display in a pop-up dialog to users logged into Manitou and acknowledged, the acknowledgment notes who and when within the System Log.

### Edits

Lists all changes made to all elements of Manitou. This can be further filtered by specific qualifiers such as Customer, Dealer, Event codes, and the list goes on.

### Report Scheduler

Lists the successes, and failures, of the scheduler to notify the report server to run a scheduled report.

### User Messages

Lists any messages including to whom, the date and time, and the text of the messages communicated through the messenger within Manitou.

### Alarm Mode

Notes the entry, and exit, into, and out of, Alarm Handling Mode.

### Reverse Command

Notes which reverse commands were sent by whom and when.

### Miscellaneous

Documents when a Private Contact was revealed to which operator or which operator sent a Manual signal.

### Edit Detail

This currently returns no information.

### PBX Assistant

When licensed, this returns transactions processed by the PBX Assistant



Manitou System Logs contain many filters to provide insights on how users are behaving within Manitou. This document details the filters and the advantages of the filters available.
