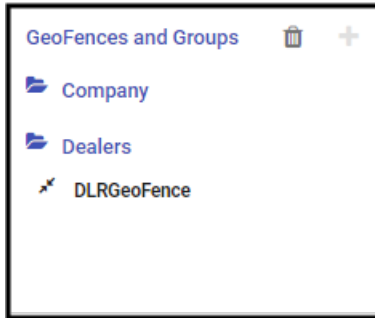


Dealer GPS Tracking

The Dealer GPS Tracking form displays the company and dealer's GeoFences and Groups.

Adding a Group and a GeoFence



1. Click the **Plus sign** (⊕) to the right of the GeoFences and Groups
2. Add the Group for the GeoFence by Selecting **Group** and Entering the **Group Name**.
3. Click **Done**.
4. Click the **Group name**.

5. Click the **Plus sign** (⊕) again.
6. Enter a name for the **GeoFence**.
7. **Choose the type of Shape** - Polygon or Circle.
8. If assigned to a specific Area, **select the Area ID**.
9. **Set the Max Speed**, if tracking a unit's speed.

10. **Choose the Alarm Condition.**

- **Entry** - Alarm is triggered by entering the fenced area.
- **Exit** - Alarm is triggered by exiting the fenced area.
- **Cross** - Alarm is triggered by entry or exiting the fenced area.

11. When all is entered as expected, click **Done**.

12. **Draw the GeoFence.**

13. **Save** (⏏) the record.
