


# Alarm Handling - Suspend

The **Alarm Handling - Suspend** action places the alarm on Hold for a specified period of time. Manitou allows the action to also set a new priority.

- **Suspend Period** - How long to suspend the event.
  - **Interval** - Seconds, Minutes, Hours.
