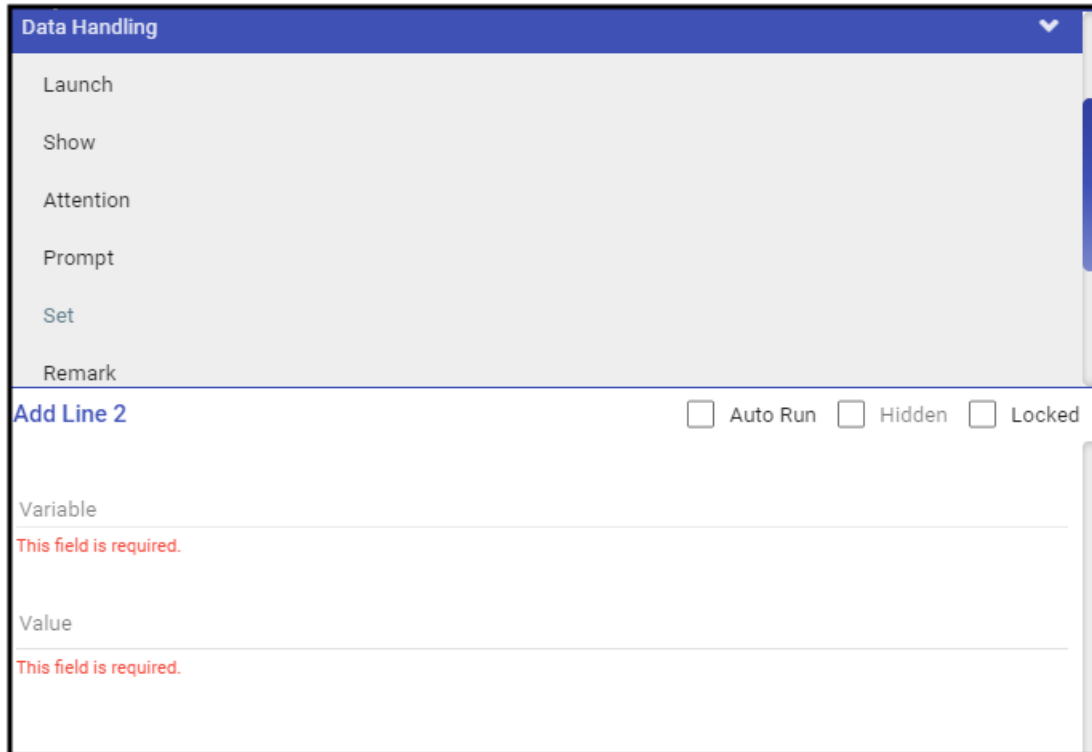


# Data Handling - Set

The **Data Handling Set** command allows the establishment of specific values that are used for logic or other data management for alarm processing.
