

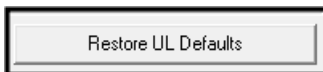
SWS - Maintenance - Setup - Subtypes - UL Defaults

At some point it may be necessary to **reset** Manitou's **UL defaults**. UL is an abbreviation for **Underwriter's Laboratories**. The UL is a testing and certification body for alarm software development, as well as for Central Station alarm handling procedures.

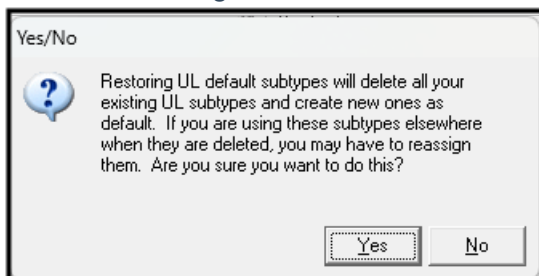
UL developed a list of categories and Subtypes that must be included in alarm software if the software is to be UL-certified. Manitou meets these basic UL standards but also allows users to add Subtypes in addition to the minimum requirements for UL certification. Thus, a user may, at some point, want to restore Manitou to only those Subtypes deemed necessary by the UL.

Restore UL Defaults

1. Navigate to the **Maintenance → Setup → Subtypes**.
2. Click **Edit**.
3. Click **Restore UL Defaults**.



4. **Review** the warning.



5. When sure, click **Yes**.
